**ELLIS DIVERSIFIED, INC. CHOOSES L&A INTERIORS TO CREATE

The designers also gave Wilton Station's centerpiece, the spectacular, state-of-the-art W Club, an exciting and impressive décor that sets the approximately 8,000 square-foot facility apart as a fitness, entertainment and water-oriented experience.

"We designed the W Club to be fun and inviting—a great place to be," said Retterath. "The vivid gold, burgundy and lime green colors set the tone, and we integrated cool patterns and artwork to finish the look. The result is amazing."

With all of its buildings under construction on a 10-acre site overlooking the scenic Middle River, Wilton Station has attracted those who appreciate a laid-back, casual lifestyle and the perfect ambiance for home entertainment. The popular two-

story brownstone residences occupy the first two levels of each of the community's six handsome 5-story buildings. The gated, pet-friendly community offers an unusually wide variety of floor plans. With its distinctive architecture and park-like setting, enhanced by 300 feet of scenic riverfront, the sophisticated new community has created a growing "buzz" in the area as an attractive alternative to traditional single-family homes and towering high-rise life.
